"Lyapis Trubetskoy" is a Soviet and Belarusian punk rock band, named after the comic hero of the novel by Ilya Ilf and Yevgeny Petrov "The Twelve Chairs", the hack poet Nikifor Lyapis, who was published under the pseudonym Trubetskoy.

Winner of RAMP, Rock Coronation, Chart Dozen, Steppenwolf, ZD Awards, Ultra-Music Awards.

On March 17, 2014, Sergey Mikhailok announced the dissolution of the group, and on August 31, the group ceased its activities[2] and split into two bands: Brutto and Trubetskoy.

The group resumed operations in 2022 amid Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

### **1989-1999:**

The group was formed in September 1989 and gave its first concert at the Three Colors festival in Minsk. The leader from the very beginning was a student of the Belarusian Institute of Culture **Sergei Mikhailok**. Other members of the first line-up of the band were bass guitarist **Dmitry Sviridovich**, guitarist **Ruslan Vladyko** and drummer **Alexei Lyubavin**.

The band members got together mostly at concerts. Their transition to the "real" occurred after the first serious performance of the group at the "Festival of Musical Minorities" in the Teacher's House in Minsk. Since then, the musicians began to meet regularly and rehearse.

The next stage in the history of Lyapis Trubetskoy was a meeting with the future director of the team, **Evgeny Kolmykov**, in 1994. For the very first solo performance, he offered the musicians a fee - at a beer show in the Vremya cafe in the recreation center of the Minsk Tractor Plant. Around this time, the group's first tour of the republic (by bus) took place as part of Next Stop New Life, in which the audience was presented with the rock opera Conquest of Space jointly with the Bamboo Theater (headed by **Sergey Mikhailok**).

Then in 1994 the Lyapis Trubetskoy group took part in the "KG. Angry Holiday", which took place in the Minsk Sports Palace with the participation of Russian groups Chaif, 2va Samoleta, Chufella Marzufella and others. A little later, the musicians ended up at the Gagarin's Unknown Cinema festival, invented by the artist Vasily Pochitsky, where Zartipo (Belarusian) Russian also performed. and "Khlamkin Goes to Israel". The success of the concert led to the idea of releasing a cassette. As a result, a recording was made of a performance at the Alternative Theater during the Rock Subscription, which was released under the title "*Любови капей!*" (*Love Kapets!*) (not to be confused with the 1998 collection). The first edition was about 100 pieces, of which only twenty were sold (later, in the wake of the success of the "*Ранетое сердце*" (*Wounded Heart*) album, it was reissued). In 1995, everyone went about their own business: **Evgeny Kolmykov** worked in the Club Style association, **Sergey Mikhailok** oversaw the Addis Abbeba club and directed the Bambuki theater (all actors are men, by analogy with the Japanese Kabuki theater). By that time, in addition to **Mikhailok**, the group included **Ruslan Vladyko** (guitar), **Alexei Lyubavin** (drums) and **Valery Bashkov** (bass).

Everything changed in 1996 after a concert at the Palace of Chess and Checkers. It was there that Evgeny Kravtsov from Complexbank noticed them and offered to record at the Mezzo-Forte studio. The group was reinforced by **Egor Dryndin** (trumpet), **Vitaly Drozdov** (violin, vocals), **Pavel Kuzyukovich** (horn) and **Alexander Rolov** (guitar). The result was the album "*Ранетое сердце*" (*Wounded Heart*), officially presented on June 21, 1996 at the rock festival "Kupalle z" Belarusian Maladzezhnaya "" in Gorky Park in Minsk. The hit of the performance was the song "*Лу-ка-шен-ко*" (*Lu-ka-shen-ko*), which was not included in the album, based on the tune from the movie "The Adventures of Pinocchio". On the first day of sales, all 200 cassettes brought with them were sold out.

During the presentation of the new program of the Smyarotnaya group, which took place on October 4, 1996, in the Palace of Trade Unions in Minsk, there were as many spectators in the hall packed to capacity as those who remained on the street. Sales of "*Ранетое сердце*" (*Wounded Heart*), according to various estimates (cassettes were published by anyone, and no one knows the exact number), ranged from 20 to 30 thousand copies.

By the end of 1996, signs began to appear that among the large army of conquered fans, more and more of those who were disappointed in Lyapis began to appear, which was greatly facilitated by the hype around the musicians. At first, it was not so noticeable, because the flow of new fans continued to block the "departed" old ones, but gradually the situation changed. The press turned from all-loving into all-hating, with the exception of the magazine "Ushi", to which **Yevgeny Kolmykov** had the most direct relationship.

However, the apotheosis of the rise was the third ceremony of presenting the Belarusian music awards "Rock-Coronation-96". Lyapis Trubetskoy received three awards with four nominations. "Best Lyricist of the Year" (shared with Kasia Kamotskaya from the Belarusian group "New Heaven (Belarusian Russian)", "Album of the Year" and "Best Group of the Year" (the so-called "Big Crown", which meant that "Lyapis Trubetskoy" is now the "rock king").

"Lyapis Trubetskoy" disappears for a year. The impression was created (not only by itself, but also by the press) that **Mikhailok** had written himself out and the group was finished. The release of a "compensatory" live recording from the presentation of the program "Смяротнае вяселле" (Smyarotnae vyaselle) did not save either.

In 1996, **Vasily Shugaley** took the group's cassette to Moscow, where it aroused interest from Ton Studio Soyuz (a branch of Soyuz that prepares projects for sale to other firms). The album "*Ты кинула*" (*You Threw*) with half of the old and half of the new songs is being recorded, which in 1997 "lays on the shelf" due to the fact that several Moscow companies began to fight for Lyapis Trubetskoy at once. On top of that, the group pursued a policy of not trying to sell out to just anyone, and the program comes out only in early 1998. During his recording, **Oleg Lado** and **Vitaly Drozdov** leave the band. First, at first, as a session musician, **Valery Bashkov** replaces (with him several songs were recorded for "*Ты кинула*" (*You Threw*), but a little later the bass guitarist of the first line-up **Dmitry Sviridovich** returns. In place of Drozdov, the second vocalist **Pavel Bulatnikov** (a former member of the Minsk duo "Lyceum") comes. At the end of 1997, the director's tandem "Bolek & Lolek" filmed the first video clip in the history of the group - "*Ау*" (*Au*). This clip was made from computer-processed "Zenith" photographs of the Lyapis, as well as using plasticine animation.

You threw the group success in Russia and CIS countries. This is facilitated by the continuous tour of musicians. In the spring of 1998, Lyapis Trubetskoy made its first tour of Belarus in a year and a half, which was a great success. The significantly increased level of musicianship, the success of the band in Russia and new songs rehabilitated "Lyapisov" in their homeland. At the end of 1998, an album of remixes of songs by the Lyapisdens group was released, the creation of which the musicians themselves have nothing to do with, and in August, at the initiative of Soyuz and Evgeny Kravtsov, a collection of "archival" recordings of the "*Любови капец: архивные записи*" (*Lyubov Kapets: archival recordings*) group was released. On Russian radio stations, the version of **Oleg Kvasha's** song "*Зеленоглазое такси*" (*Green-Eyed Taxi*), recorded in 1996 for the "*Раненого сердца*" (*Wounded Heart*), becomes a hit, which, at the same time, turns into a pretext for a scandal raised by the author of the song in early 1999.

In the fall of 1998, the preparation of material for a new album begins, the recording of which begins at the end of the year. Disk "*Красота*" (*The Beauty*) is diverse in mood and musically. The album is released on May 12, and the musicians again begin active touring, a significant place in which is the participation in the non-political part of the "Yes!" tour. In September-October. In autumn, the preparation of new material begins. The first song, "*Виноградная лоза*" (*Vine*), is recorded in Minsk at the "Mezzo-forte" studio in September and mixed in France by English producer Victor Pendlebury.

#### **2000:**

In January 2000, a new album with the working title "*Тяжкий*" (*Tyazhky*) (Heavy) was recorded in Minsk at the Belarusian television studio. Pendlebury arrives for the second week of recording, when everything is almost ready. He remains satisfied with the direction of the work and as a result is directly engaged only in mixing the material. Lyapis signed a contract with the leading Russian record company Real Records, which released their new album on May 15 of the same year.

"*Тяжкий*" (*Tyazhky*) (Heavy) caused a mixed reaction. The program directors of Moscow radio stations were reluctant to take songs from "*Тяжкий*" (*Tyazhky*) on their air, MTV and ORT refused to play the clips "*Дружбан*" and "*По аллеям*" (*Along the Alleys*) (filmed with the participation of the comedian troupe "Maski-show"). But Artemy Troitsky called "*Тяжкий*" (*Tyazhky*) the best that was published in Russia in 2000."

Studio "Soyuz" re-released her album "*Красота*" (*Beauty*) called "*Всем девочкам нравится...*" (*All the girls like...*). The reissue included three new songs - "*Любовь повернулась ко мне задом*" (*Love turned its back on me*), "*Крошка моя*" (*My little one*) (a cover version of the group's hit "Руки Вверх!" (Hands up!)) and "*Виноградная лоза*" (*Vine*). At the same time, a musical film about the group "*Всем девочкам нравится...*" (*All the girls like...*) is released.

The video for the first hit from the upcoming album "*Голуби*" (*Doves*) (release was scheduled for autumn 2001) was shot in Minsk by director Igor Pashkevich. The video was filmed in early January at the Minsk Bicycle Plant. For two nights, the Lapis portrayed some proletarian hooligans chasing beautiful girls in feathers and sequins. The clip was taken as an MTV exclusive and in March 2001 became the most rotated video on this channel.

In the same March, the musicians of the group initiated the creation of the creative association "*Дети Солнца*" (*Children of the Sun*). The purpose of the association is to promote cheerful positive music, regardless of who performs it - recognized stars or talented newcomers. In order to promote this idea, the eponymous record label "*Дети Солнца*" (*Children of the Sun*) was created, whose style priorities are ska, reggae, "gypsy" and other "solar music". By the end of the year, two collections were published.

#### **2001:**

Sergei Mikhailok and Pavel Bulatnikov, spring 2001.

In the summer of 2001, a video was shot for the song "*Сочи*" (*Sochi*), which, like "*Голуби*" (*Doves*), was a great success. On this wave, in September, the album "*Юность*" (*Yunost*) was released - the group's most successful disc since "*Красота*" (*Beauty*) (*Krasota*). Shortly after the release of the album, the permanent drummer of Lyapisov, **Alexei Lyubavin**, left the group. **Alexander Storozhuk**, ex-member of the Apple Tea jazz band, took his place on drums.

#### **2002-2003:**

Over time, the group began to think about a new album. The first recording attempts were made in the fall of 2002. In January 2003 we went to Kyiv to see Evgeny Stupka. Two of the six songs recorded were included in the experimental maxi-single "*Чырвоны калсыны*" (*Chyrvony Pantsy*) (May 2003), which also included a large number of remixes from the group's friends. After several trials, Lyapis chose the Minsk studio Selah, where Andrey Zhukov works. It was he who at one time recorded the first cassette album of the Lyapis Trubetskoy group "*Раненое сердце*" (*Wounded Heart*).

#### **2004-2005:**

The result of almost a year of work was the album "*Золотые яйца*" (*Golden Eggs*) (April 2004), the sound of which was noticeably more "independent", with a fairly strong influence of ska and reggae. By the time of its release, video clips had been shot for the songs "*Раинька*" (*Rainka*) and "*Золотые яйца*" (*Golden Eggs*). In mid-March 2004, **Sergei Mikhailok** shaved his head, explaining this act with a desire to start a new life. Sergey also began to actively go in for sports, and

in the summer of 2004 he shaved off his mustache, thereby finally changing his classic image. In August 2004, a video for the song "Почтальоны" (*Postmen*) (a Russian-language cover of the **Secret Service** song "Ten o'clock Postman"), filmed by American director Kevin Jackson, appeared.

In 2004-2005, Lyapis Trubetskoy was actively engaged in soundtracks. **Sergei Mikhailok's** team is recording music for the TV series "Мужчины не плачут" (*Men Don't Cry*) and the film "Последний забой" (*The Last Slaughter*) (both directed by Russian director Sergei Bobrov).

At the same time, in the summer of 2005, the team began work in the studio on their next numbered disc. The first new songs ("Андрюша" (*Andryusha*), "Харэ" (*Khare*) were presented to listeners even before the studio recording at the festivals "Invasion", in Kazakhstan and Russia, having received very positive feedback - the live recording of "Харэ" (*Khare*) made in Emmaus even hit the hit parade "Our Radio". Also, "Lapisy" began to prepare a duet with the Moldovan group Zdob și Zdub for the future disc. On November 25, 2005, a big solo concert of "lyapis" took place in the "Orange" club, during which the musicians performed all their hits, as well as two new compositions. At the same time, the first recordings of the new album began, the following were recorded: "Харэ" (*Khare*), "Андрюша" (*Andryusha*), "Товарищ" (*Comrade*).

#### **2006:**

March 2006 was marked by the release of the album "Мужчины не плачут" (*Men Don't Cry*), which included material recorded by the group in 2004-2005, mainly soundtracks for Russian TV series.

In the first half of 2006, one of the founders of the band returned to the group - bass guitarist **Dmitry Sviridovich**, who replaced the multi-instrumentalist **Vladimir Yolkín**. In this line-up, the group continued to work on a new album, and also began touring again. In May 2006, the team performed at the Tavria Games.

In November, the new video clip "Харэ" (*Khare*) was in the rotation of various music TV channels. In December 2006, **Dmitry Sviridovich** left the band once again, and was replaced by bass player **Denis Sturchenko**. During this period of time, the group changes the working title of the album to "Капитал" (*Capital*).

#### **2007:**

In April 2007, an animated video for the song "Капитал" (*Capital*) by Alexei Terekhov appeared on the Internet; in it, **Mikhailok** was depicted as a multi-armed deity with a piggy bank instead of a heart, traveling on an incomprehensible animal around the world, completely destroyed by globalization. The clip received a prize at the RAMP ceremony in the "Clip of the Year" nomination and a Chart Dozen award in the "Video Clip" category.

On May 1, the presentation of the new album "Капитал" (*Capital*) took place in the club "Orange". The songs in the album are full of sharp socio-political satire, which was unusual for the band before. In May 2007, active touring began in support of the new album.

On May 12, 2007, within the framework of the MTV program "Full Contact", a "cultural scuffle" took place between the groups "Lyapis Trubetskoy" and "Vopli Vidoplyasova". In the end, the Lyapis won. On September 29, 2007, the shooting of the concert of the Lyapis Trubetskoy group took place in the Tochka club. The director of the filming was V. Chizhov, an old friend of the Lyapisov.

#### **2008:**

In January 2008, the Lyapis began work on a new album. On February 1, 2008, the group released a new composition "Манифест" (*Manifesto*). On February 15, 2008, the first live DVD in the band's history was released under the title "Капитал: Концерт в клубе. Точка" (*Capital: Concert at the Tochka Club*). On the same day, a big solo concert "Lyapisov" took place in the "Shadow" club. In addition to "Манифест" (*Manifesto*), the group also played a new composition called "Хэндэ хох" (*Khende Hoch*) (later renamed "Рок-нунсы" (*Rock Baby Dolls*)).

The premiere of the clip "Золотая антилопа" (*Golden Antelope*) took place on the portal "LiveJournal", which caused a very controversial reaction from the public.

On February 16, 2008, the Lyapis performed at the big combined concert "Chart's Dozen" in St. Petersburg.

In May 2008, the group officially closed the "year of Capital". On May 9, Lyapis gave a performance at the Minsk Palace of Sports, which gathered more than 7.5 thousand spectators and became the largest concert of the group and one of the largest solo concerts of Belarusian performers in Minsk. On May 16, 2008, the last concert with the program "Capital" took place - in the Moscow club "Tochka".

At both concerts, the musicians presented their new compositions to the public: "Манифест" (*Manifesto*), "Рок-нунсы" (*Rock Baby Dolls*), "Зорачкі" (*Zorachki*), "Жлоб" (*Redneck*).

The premiere of the Manifesto program took place on September 14, 2008 in Vitebsk at the Summer Amphitheatre. Then the "Lapis" went on their "Manifesto Tour" in Russia.

The album "Манифест" (*Manifesto*) was originally scheduled for release on October 24, 2008, between January and September 2008. However, the musicians of the group once again pleasantly surprised the public by posting their new album for free on the Internet (on the portals Tut.By, Afisha.ru, Afisha.ua), and a month ahead of schedule. Simultaneously with the album, the first video for the song from the new album, "Жлоб" (*Redneck*), appeared on the network. On October 24 and November 21, the disc was presented in the biggest clubs in Moscow B1 Maximum and St. Petersburg (GlavClub).

November 7, 2008 on the portal Nashe.ru premiered the clip "Lyapisov" "Огоньки" (*Lights*) (directed by Alexei Terekhov). A few days after that, a certain "group of young Moscow communists" combined the Ogonkov video sequence with the song of the Underwood team "I really want to go to the Soviet Union" and posted the result on the main page of the official website of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation and the website of the MGK of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation.

On December 19, the group gave a sold-out concert in the Moscow club B2 - and thus completed the first part of the Manifesto Tour.

#### **2009:**

The beginning of 2009 was marked for the band members by receiving music awards: ZD-Awards, Chart Dozen, Rock Coronation. On March 9, 2009, the next solo performance of Lyapisov took place in the Minsk Palace of Sports - this event, according to some reports, gathered a maximum of 4 thousand people. It was broadcast live on the Belarusian Internet radio station NETradio. Two new compositions were presented: "*Буревестник*" (*Petrel*) and "*Качки*" (*Kachki*). [??]

At the same time, the group began recording their next studio album - "*Культпросвет*" (*Cultural Enlightenment*).

On March 27, 2009, the band's first DVD release with a collection of clips took place - "*Парад-Алле*" (*Parade-Alle*). The deluxe edition also includes the "*Капитал*" (*Capital*) and "*Манифест*" (*Manifesto*) albums with bonus tracks.

In May 2009, the band embarked on their first American tour. "Lyapis Trubetskoy" visited a number of cities, including Washington and Boston. Upon returning from the USA, the Lyapis began the final stage of recording the album. In the summer of 2009, the group performed at a number of festivals - "Kubana", "Russian Lessons", "Navalnitsa", "Air", "Rock-Line".

On August 24, 2009, the album "*Культпросвет*" (*Kultprosvet*) (*Cultural Enlightenment*) was published for free download on the Kroogi Internet portal. The CD with the album "*Культпросвет*" (*Cultural Enlightenment*) was released on September 1, 2009. In the first week of September, the album became the bestseller in the Soyuz and Respublika stores.

October 28, 2009 at the ceremony "RAMP 2009" (awards in the field of alternative music), the ensemble received two statuettes at once - in the nomination "Clip of the Year" ("*Огоньки*" (*Lights*)) and "Group of the Year".

On December 11, 2009, the group performed in Moscow at the Olimpiysky Sports Complex at a concert dedicated to the 40th anniversary of the Time Machine group, where they performed the Time Machine song "*Скворец*" (*Starling*) and their own "*Манифест*" (*Manifesto*). On the same day, the tribute album "*Машины Времени - Машинопуть*" (*Time Machine - Typewriting*) was presented, which included the song "*Скворец*" (*Starling*) performed by "Lyapisov".

## **2010:**

"Lyapis Trubetskoy" released a collection of "Agitpop" in Germany, collaborating with the Eastblock Music label. In addition to 18 tracks, the disc includes remixes of the song "*Капитал*" (*Capital*) by Igor Vdovin and Noize MC .

In the summer of 2010, Lyapis Trubetskoy performed on the main stage as one of the headliners at the Sziget festival. In August, one of the headliners of the Dobrofest and Kubana festivals.

On November 7, the group released the single "Священный огонь" (Sacred Fire), consisting of three new tracks, one of which - "*Африка*" (*Africa*) - is a remake of the group's song "*Комитет охраны тепла*" (*Heat Protection Committee*).

In November, trumpeter **Pavel Kuzukovich** left the group; his place was taken by **Vlad Senkevich**.

## **2011:**

On February 1, the song "*Я верю*" (*I Believe*) appeared on the network, and on February 14, a video for it. On February 10, the band began a concert tour dedicated to the release of their new album "*Весёлые картинки*" (*Funny Pictures*), which was released on March 9 on the Internet and on March 14 on CD-carriers. The album is currently available for free download on the Internet.

In the Belarusian blogosphere there is a list of banned for mentioning in the official media. "Workers of art and creative teams". To the list included both Belarusian and foreign creative people. Among them is the Lyapis Trubetskoy group. Due to the "black list" in March, concerts in Gomel (March 13) and Mogilev (March 20) did not take place, and the group's concerts on April 1 and 2 in the Minsk club "Reactor" were also canceled. Canceled Lyapis concerts in Molodechno, Soligorsk, Zhlobin, respectively, April 5, 6, 10.

In May 2011, drummer **Alexander Storozhuk** left the band, with whom the Lyapis worked for a decade. His place was taken by **Denis Shurov**, who previously played in the Belarusian team "Without a Ticket".

In August 2011, the group presented a video for the song "*Принцесса*" (*Princess*).

In October, the media reported that a criminal case could be initiated against the leader of the group in his home country for publicly insulting President **Alexander Lukashenko**, but the prosecutor's office said that they did not reveal any violations by **Mikhailok**.

## **2012:**

The harbinger of the new album was the song on the verses of Yanka Kupala "*Не быць скотам!*" (*Don't be cattle!*), which "*Ляписы*" (*Lyapisy*) presented back in November 2011. The release of the "*Рабкор*" (*Rabkor*) album took place on May 1.

In 2012, "Lyapis Trubetskoy" gave more than a hundred solo concerts with the programs "*Не быць скотам!*" (*Don't be cattle!*) and "*Рабкор*" (*Rabkor*), as well as performed at all major open-air in Russia and neighboring countries. All visitors to the final concert of the Rabkor Live program were given discs of the same name, and "*Рабкор Live*" (*Rabkor Live*) became their first live album released in a limited edition.

The musicians also became triumphant of the Russian rock award "Chart's Dozen", having won in three nominations at once: "Group", "Poetry" and "Video clip". The song "*Шум*" (*Jester*) at the end of the year entered the top three most popular tracks of the hit parade "Chartova Dozen" ("OUR Radio").

## **2013:**

The band started 2013 with a short rest, which the musicians decided to take before the end of the "*Ра́бкоп Live*" (*Rabkor Live*) tour in Izhevsk. On January 31, **Sergei Mikhailok** gave the first long interview in a year to the popular Rolling Stone magazine, in which he compared **Putin** to **Lukashenka**, and also explained why he stopped drinking and why he did not return to Minsk.

On February 8, the premiere of the film-concert "*Ра́бкоп Live*" (*Rabkor Live*) took place, which included the best moments from the presentations of "*Ра́бкоп*" (*Rabkor*) in Koktebel, Vilnius, Moscow, Kyiv and St. Petersburg. The Russian Internet premiere of the film took place on the Lenta.ru website, the Belarusian one - on TUT.BY, the Ukrainian one - on LB.ua.

On February 20, 2013, the "*Lyapis Crew*" video premiered on the group's official YouTube channel on the eve of the tour of the same name, which started on March 1 in Kazan and lasted until the end of 2013.

In August 2013, the group performed at the Kubana music festival, in September - at the Vozdukh live music festival, which was held in Karelia. At the end of August, the release of the first Belarusian-language compilation album called "*Гра́й*" (*Gray*) was also announced. On September 6, the group performed as a headliner at a rally-concert in support of Moscow mayoral candidate **Alexei Navalny**.

On October 16, in honor of Oldie's birthday, the Lyapis Trubetskoy and Karibasy groups released a joint mini-album called "*Oldi. Serenity Dub*".

On November 30, a concert-presentation of the program "*Гра́й*" (*Gray*) took place in Vilnius. The Belarusian portal TUT.BY organized an online broadcast of the event, which was viewed by 120,000 visitors. On December 7, the group performed at the "Maidan" in Kyiv, supporting the protesters against the power of **Yanukovich**.

On December 23, **Sergei Mikhailok**, in his New Year's Internet address, announced the name of the new album - "*Мампэўка*" (*Matryoshka*) - and the release date: March 1, 2014.

#### **2014:**

On February 3, a video for the song "*Мампэўка*" (*Matryoshka*) was released, and on March 1, 2014, the group's album called "*Мампэўка*" (*Matryoshka*) was released.

In Pskov, the group's concert planned for March 14 was canceled. The initiator of the cancellation was the Pskov Regional Committee of the Communist Party. The press service of the regional committee reported that the group plans to present in the city a new album "*Мампэўка*" (*Matryoshka*), in which "Russia is presented in the most unattractive form ... the leaders of the Soviet Union".

On March 17, the leader of the group, **Sergei Mikhailok**, announced that all spring and summer concerts would be played, but from September 1, the group would officially cease to exist.

In April, information appeared on the Internet that during a concert in Izhevsk, **Sergei Mikhailok** allegedly insulted a fan and shouted anti-Russian slogans. The material for publications was a video recording during a concert in Wuppertal (Germany), where **Mikhailok**, according to him, only reacted to the obscene and boorish behavior of a group of tipsy people.

On May 1, the group gave a concert in Alma-Ata, where they were invited to a motorcycle festival to mark the opening of the bike season. The concert ended the moto evening, which was held next to the festival site in the hangar of the Atakent exhibition complex (former VDNKh of the Kazakh SSR).

August 26, during the performance of the group in Kyiv at the stadium. Lobanovsky, **Sergey Mikhailok** thanked the Ukrainian people for their courage.

The last concert of the group took place in St. Petersburg on August 29, 2014. On August 31, on the official website of the group, it was announced that the band, which had existed for 24 years, had ceased to exist.

On September 1, the musicians' plans for the future were announced. Instead of the Lyapis Trubetskoy group, two new projects appeared. The **Trubetskoy** project, in which **Pavel Bulatnikov** will sing. He took with him two Lyapis musicians: guitarist **Ruslan Vlydyko** and drummer **Alexander Storozhuk**, as well as bassist **Alexander Myshkevich** ("J: Mors", "Without a Ticket", "Krambambulya", Chiefsband). The first single released by the group "**Trubetskoy**" was the song "Ласточка" (Swallow). It was performed at the group's concerts, but it was not recorded in the studio and was not released on the Lyapis Trubetskoy albums. **Sergey Mikhailok** created his own project called "**Brutto**", which consists of both new musicians and members of Lyapis Trubetskoy: **Denis Shurov** (drummer) and **Denis Sturchenko** (bass player).

#### **2020s:**

The band resumed touring in 2022 amid Russia's invasion of Ukraine. A charity European tour was announced in support of Ukraine.

#### Awards:

At the 13th award ceremony for the best Belarusian musicians "Rock Coronation" (March 14, 2009, Molodechno, crystal crowns were awarded in nine categories): three crystal crowns - "Song of the Year" ("Zorachki"), "Album of the Year" ("Manifesto") and "Group of the Year".
